



Doctoral fellowships available for September 2016

Department of Public Health, Babes-Bolyai University, offers six 36 months doctoral research fellowships.

Fellowships' description

Fellowships focus on scientific training and career development in pursuing the highest caliber research to promote safety and improve the health of populations. Doctoral students will receive senior mentorship and peer collaboration in a rich scientific environment as part of the Doctoral School of Administration and Public Policies.

Doctoral students are expected to collaborate on research publications and grant submissions related to population sciences, public policies, and public health. Topics of study may include: traffic safety, public policies, human resource management in health sector, health policy and management, healthcare policies and practice, social and behavioral health, community health, children and adolescent health, mental health, nutrition and physical activity, the reduction of risk taking behaviors, and others.

Doctoral students will assume responsibility for their doctoral research project, and will collaborate on ongoing projects under the supervision of their coordinator. Doctoral students will be expected to become proficient in scientific writing and in grant writing and will be strongly encouraged to conceive and lead their own grant submission as a preparation for entering the workforce at the end of the doctoral program.

Milestones will be used to determine each doctoral student's progress and suitability to enter the second and third year of the doctoral program and ultimately their completion of the doctoral degree. Doctoral students can follow one of three semi-flexible pathways with varied activities.



Options

Option 1 (#2 positions available)

Students will benefit from a monthly scholarship and will NOT pay tuition.

Activities

Attend doctoral program's courses

Attend monthly meetings with the coordinator and present the progress during department meetings

Teach 1 seminar per semester in the Bachelor Program of the Department of Public Health

Submit two to three peer-reviewed manuscripts

Publish two peer-reviewed manuscripts (1 ISI and 1 BDI)

Submit 1 grant application

Option 2 (#2 positions available)

Students will NOT benefit from a monthly scholarship and will NOT pay tuition.

Activities

Attend doctoral program's courses

Attend monthly meetings with the coordinator and present the progress during department meetings

Teach 1 seminar per semester in the Bachelor Program of the Department of Public Health

Publish two peer-reviewed manuscripts (1 ISI and 1 BDI)

Option 3 (#2 positions available)

Students will NOT benefit from a monthly scholarship and will pay for the doctoral program tuition.

Attend monthly meetings with the coordinator and present the progress during department meetings

Publish two peer-reviewed manuscripts (1 ISI and 1 BDI)
