



## Writing and submitting the abstract

### Writing the abstract

#### Abstract title

Write a brief abstract title and avoid subtitles if possible. Do not use capital letters, abbreviations or acronyms in the abstract title.

#### Authorship

##### *Presenting author*

The name of the presenting author: type the full first name before the last name (such as Jane Austin). You must also list the presenting author in the list of authors.

##### *Authors*

List the authors' names as follows: (1) full last name, (2) initials for first name, (3) titles.

##### *Affiliation(s)*

If more than one affiliation is listed, please number them. Please list the affiliation, town and country for each author contributing in writing the abstract. If all affiliations are from the same town/country, just list the town/country at the end of the affiliations' list.

#### Abstract body

**Background:** Address the scientific rationale for the study as well as the public health significance of the subject. Explain why your study is important and describe the research question(s) you're addressing in your abstract.

**Methods:** Describe the study design, study setting, study participants, the analytic and/or intervention techniques and the outcome measures.

**Abstract results:** Present the major quantitative and/or qualitative findings. Make sure you report the results highlighting your conclusion. If appropriate, state that the results are preliminary.

**Abstract conclusions:** State only those conclusions that are directly supported by data. When possible, state the innovative characteristics of your findings. Report the implication of your results for policy and/or practice.

## Submitting the abstract

Researchers and practitioners wishing to present a paper or a poster at ICONiC 2017 should submit an abstract using the following guidelines:

- An author can be the presenting author of only one abstract.
- The abstract should not exceed 3000 characters (including spaces). Please note that if you exceed this amount, the system will not accept the abstract.
- Do not include figures or tables in your abstract.
- Once submitted, it is not possible to make any corrections.
- Please indicate whether you are submitting the abstract for oral or poster presentation. If no indication is given, the abstract will first be considered for oral presentation.
